Dear Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in the Leadership Training (LT) program at Ewalu! The LT program is designed to help you develop skills for effective outdoor ministry. You'll also gain leadership tools to use in your home congregation, school, community and future vocations.

The program is for youth completing grades 10-12. Each four-week session progresses from developing leadership skills to practicing them with kids under the guidance of a camp counselor. You will be interacting with younger campers during recreation, at the camp store, at the pool and elsewhere. Each day your group will spend time growing as a community with Bible studies, discussions and workshops on a variety of topics.

The program is coordinated by a qualified, experienced Ewalu staff member. The LT Coordinator conducts many of the trainings and organizes LT activities. Other camp staff and resource people will also contribute to the program.

We offer two LT sessions each summer. This year, Session 1 is *June 13-July 2* and *July 11-16*. Session 2 is *July 18 – August 13*. Please indicate on your application form which sessions are your first and second choices. Participation is limited to one session each summer.

There is no charge for participation; LTs receive a small stipend of \$25/week, plus room and board. The camp week runs from 12:30 p.m. on Sundays through the closing program at 2 p.m. on Fridays. Weekends are time off, during which participants are not supervised by the LT coordinator or Ewalu staff.

Enclosed you will find an application and two reference forms. Please return your application to Ewalu as soon as possible. Give your reference forms to adults such as pastors, teachers or employers, who know your character and are not related to you. It may be helpful to print your name on the reference forms before you give them out. Ask each person to complete the form and mail it directly to Camp Ewalu as soon as possible.

If you have any questions, please call or email the Ewalu office. The program is limited to twelve people each session. Acceptance is based on qualifications, ability to attend the entire session, and timeliness of your application.
